3. In March 2007 the Association applied to the Robin Hood Airport Community Fund for £1,000 to cover the costs of development of the Association's website and modifying the School's Heritage Pack to become a Community Heritage Pack
4. During the Year the Association worked with Sherwood Forest Trust who funded the development of the School's Heritage Pack.
5. Experience Nottinghamshire provided the funding for internet pages about the Pilgrim Fathers heritage which form part of the Association's website.
6. During the Year Bawtry Hall, West Retford Hotel, Gainsborough Old Hall and Austerfield Study Centre provided meeting accommodation without charge.
7. Bassetlaw District Council, Doncaster Metropolitan Borough Council and West Lindsey Council jointly provided the funding to reprint the Mayflower Trail leaflet.
8. In May 2006 Bassetlaw District Council and Doncaster Metropolitan Borough Council provided the funding for the launch of the Association including the visit of Dr. Jeremy Bangs and colleagues and a tour of Pilgrim Country.
9. In March 2007 the Management Group agreed to ask the associated local authorities to each provide an annual contribution of £400 to cover the ongoing administration costs of the Association for the year to 31st March 2008 .
